WHO WE HELP - Liz's story

A transplant from Texas, Liz was diagnosed last year while living in Tahoe. Without insurance, she couldn't afford health care or rent, so she and her husband moved in with her sister in San Rafael. While she was in treatment, Liz found out about the Marin Center for Independent Living. MCIL helped her pay rent, buy food and pay bills.
