Thirty years ago, a group of strong, visionary women saw a critical need in our community and answered the call. At our 30th Anniversary Stepping Out gala, we had the profound honor of celebrating the 2025 models, welcoming back 30-year alumni models and shining a spotlight on our extraordinary founders. Your courage, spark, and enduring commitment laid the foundation for everything we are today.

Because of that foundation — and 30 years of unwavering support from our donors, sponsors, board members, volunteers and caring medical community, our *Breast Cancer Grants Program* has now distributed over \$7.2 million to 67 Bay Area organizations since our inception.

In 2025 alone, that legacy of generosity translated into tangible, life-saving action. Our grantee organizations provided 3,740 critical emergency and direct services to 2,542 underserved individuals. Grant-funded navigation and diagnostic services identified 28 breast cancer diagnoses, allowing these individuals to immediately begin life-saving treatment. This funding acts as a vital safety net, alleviating the financial and health burdens of a diagnosis so patients can focus entirely on healing.

To our generous donors who fund this work, our dedicated volunteers who give so selflessly of their time, and my fellow board members — you are the heartbeat of this foundation. We truly could not do this without you. Thank you for walking alongside us for the last 30 years, and for continuing to bring us closer to a future where hope, dignity, and support are guaranteed to everyone in need.

To Celebrate Life awards \$240,000 in 2025 to 14 Bay Area nonprofit organizations.

We proudly awarded \$240,000 in grant funding to 14 outstanding Bay Area nonprofit organizations which support women and men with breast health issues.

Grant recipients are located throughout the nine-county Bay Area. These organizations provide emergency and direct services, diagnostic screening, financial assistance, patient navigation, holistic complementary therapies and emotional support programs to underserved breast cancer patients.

This year's grant recipients were chosen from a pool of applicants by the Foundation's Grants Review Committee, which consists of community health and medical leaders, supporters, past and present Foundation board directors, many who have personally experienced breast cancer.

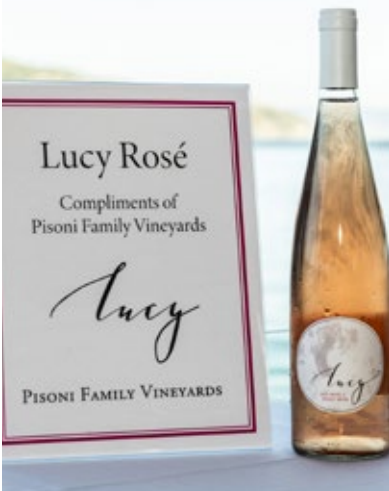
